New military station in Assam to boost border security, intelligence: Experts

GUWAHATI, NOV 12 /--/ Amid apprehensions of increased cross-border crimes, activities by fundamentalist groups and alleged attempts by the Bangladesh caretaker government to create "pressure" on the 'chicken's neck' corridor that connects the North East with the rest of India, the upcoming army base in Assam has assumed special significance, experts said.

Such a facility will boost border security and help the authorities concerned enhance intelligence, they said.

Barely 40 km from the international border with Bangladesh, the Lachit Borphukan Military Station is being set up by the Indian Army at Bamunigaon in Assam's Dhubri district - the first one in the western sector of the state.

Lieutenant General RC Tiwari, General Officer Commanding-in-Chief, Eastern Command, laid the foundation stone for the facility last week during a visit to forward areas.

"The decision to set up the camp is a welcome one due to the prevailing situation in Bangladesh," Brigadier (ret'd) Ranjit Kumar Borthakur told PTI.

The closest military camps were previously in Cooch Behar in West Bengal and Tamulpur in Assam.

"The one in Dhubri will help the Army in strengthening its intelligence network, be it human or signal



intelligence," he said. Defence spokesperson Lt Col. Mahendra Rawat underscored the importance of the camp and said that it will enhance operational capabilities and infrastructure of the Indian Army in the region.

"It will help monitor activities in the area and also lend an additional sense of security to the locals," he said.

The new military station under the Tezpur-based 4 Corps will be able to house 1,200-1,500 personnel, and pre-fabricated huts are being installed for early completion of the facility, another Army official said.

"The land was handed over by the Assam

government within one or two months, and work is on to operationalise the facility at the earliest. A paramilitary unit will also be stationed there," he added.

"The Lachit Borphukan Military Station stands as a testament to the synergy between the armed forces and the state administration, reflecting the shared vision of national security and regional development," Lt Col. Rawat emphasised.

Stressing its significance from a security aspect, Brig. (ret'd) Borthakur said, "Since the caretaker government has come into power in Bangladesh, their attitude has tremendously hardened against India. And there is the nexus with

Pakistan. The frequent high-level visits of politicians as well as defence ministry personnel from Pakistan are of great concern."

He also mentioned statements by Bangladesh caretaker government's chief Muhammad Yunus regarding India, especially his comments on the Siliguri corridor or 'chicken's neck', and allowing China to activate Lalmonirhat airfield in the neighbouring country, which is close to this 22-km corridor that serves as the link between the North East and the rest of India.

"The Siliguri corridor is always important to us, and we are fully prepared for any situation. However, we

can be more active in this regard," the retired brigadier added.

He said that while border management is being done "adequately by BSF and other agencies, the Army has to develop intelligence abilities, including signal and human intelligence, and the new Dhubri camp will be helpful". Smuggling, illegal migration, cattle smuggling and increased threat of fundamentalists' activities are longstanding concerns from Bangladesh for India, Borthakur added.

"The new camp is a good step in ensuring more preparedness by the security forces," he emphasised. PTI

ZPM, MNF announce candidates for LADC polls in Mizoram

AIZAWL, NOV 12 /--/ Mizoram's ruling Zoram People's Movement (ZPM) and main opposition Mizo National Front (MNF) on Wednesday released names of their candidates for the upcoming elections to the Lai Autonomous District Council (LADC).

Polling for the 25-member LADC, one of the three autonomous districts in the state, will be held on December 3. Votes will be counted on December 9. ZPM president Lalliansawta announced the names of 25 candidates during a function held at the party office in Aizawl. He said the party formed an 8-member search committee to scout and study the best contenders for the LADC polls as about 116 people expressed their willingness to contest the polls. The final 25 candidates were selected carefully by a secret ballot.

MNF president Zoramthanga announced the names of party candidates for the LADC polls in a function held at the party office here. The party will contest all the 25 seats in the Lai council. Congress spokesperson Lallianchunga said the party will name its nominees after the Dampa bypoll results on November 14.

According to BJP media convener Johny Lalthanpuia, the party will finalise its list in consultation with the central leadership before making it public. According to the schedule

announced by the Mizoram State Election Commission, the last date for filing nomination papers is November 14, while candidates can withdraw their names latest by November 17. A total of 56,873 voters, including 29,019 women, are eligible to exercise their franchise in the LADC polls held in 2020, the MNF, then the ruling party of the state, won 20 out of the 25 seats, while the BJP and Congress bagged one each. Three independent candidates were also elected. The term of the present council will expire on December 18.

The LADC was created in 1972 under the sixth schedule for the Lai tribal people. Besides the 25 elected members, it has 4 nominated members. PTI

Heroin worth around Rs 1.3 cr seized in Assam, 2 women held

GUWAHATI, NOV 12 /--/ In two operations of drug haul, heroin worth nearly Rs 1.3 crore was seized and two women were arrested from the capital city of Assam, police said on Wednesday.

Acting on a tip-off, a raid was conducted at Khanapara in the Basistha Police Station limits this morning, and a woman was apprehended, Guwahati Police said in a post on X. The 47-year-old woman hails from Churachandpur in Manipur, it added.

"Recovered: 12 soap boxes containing heroin weighing 138 grams (without soap boxes) and one mobile phone. Legal action initiated," the police said.

In another operation in the jurisdiction of the same police station, a raid was conducted at a rented house in Khanapara locality on the basis of an intelligence input, the police said.

A woman was arrested and the police recovered two tobacco boxes containing 22 grams of heroin, three stolen mobile phones and Rs 13,000 in cash, a senior officer said.

The total value of the seized drugs will be around Rs 1.28 crore as per the Narcotics Control Bureau (NCB) standards, he added. PTI

ISF team exposes irregularities in DIET Kalachand B.Ed. admissions; demands merit-based corrections

HAF LONG, NOV 12 /--/ The Indigenous Students Forum (ISF) team visited the District Institute of Education and Training (DIET) in Kalachand and engaged in a detailed discussion with the Principal over alleged serious anomalies in the B.Ed. admission process. According to the ISF, the Principal revealed that while the first and second admission lists were prepared strictly on merit, the third list was compiled solely based on recommendations from the Council, bypassing qualified candidates who had cleared the



entrance examination. The ISF described the practice as "highly unjust and unacceptable," stating that it undermines the integrity of the entrance exam and deprives meritorious students of their rightful seats. Such interference, the team added, erodes the credibility of educational institutions and shatters students' trust in a fair and transparent system—particularly in teacher education, which plays a pivotal role in shaping the nation's future. In a strong statement, the ISF insisted that merit must be the sole criterion for admissions across all educational institutions. The team demanded immediate corrective measures from the Council to rectify the irregularities and ensure all future admissions adhere strictly to merit.

Warning of escalation, the ISF stated that failure to act promptly would compel them to launch a full-scale agitation to amplify their demands and seek justice for affected students. The development has sparked concerns among aspirants and education stakeholders, with calls growing for greater oversight in admission procedures at teacher training institutes. Authorities from the Council have yet to issue an official response.

National Bird Day celebrated at Panidehing Bird Sanctuary to inspire bird conservation

GUWAHATI, NOV 12 /--/ To mark National Bird Day, leading biodiversity conservation organisation **Aranyaak** (www.aranyaak.org) organised a special awareness programme

today at Panidehing Bird Sanctuary, Sivasagar district of Assam, with active participation from school students and officials of the Forest Department.

The event was aimed at

fostering awareness about the importance of bird conservation and inspiring young minds to appreciate avian diversity.

The day began with an early morning bird-watching session at Foklai

Beel and Demow River, where students learned the basics of bird identification and observed a variety of resident and migratory species in their natural habitats. PTI

Assam govt and JSW sign agreement to set up world-class heritage museum

GUWAHATI, NOV 12 /--/ The Assam government and the JSW Group have signed an agreement to set up a world-class heritage museum in the city, with the inaugural exhibition to showcase the 17th-century devotional textile 'Vrindavani Vastra'.

According to an official release on Tuesday, the museum, dedicated to the preservation and promotion of art, culture and heritage, will come up on a 45,000 sq ft site at the sericulture farm in Khanapara. The Assam government has allotted the land for the museum, which will be constructed and fully funded by the JSW Group. The museum will serve as a hub for national and international artefacts, travelling exhibitions and cultural showcases, creating opportunities for global cultural exchange. The inaugural exhibition will feature the Vrindavani Vastra, the devotional textile woven under the spiritual guidance of Srimanta Sankardev, which is currently preserved at the British Museum in London. Chief Minister Himanta Biswa Sarma said the museum will be a source of immense pride for the state.

"It will not only bring the sacred Vrindavani Vastra home but will also provide a state-of-the-art facility for showcasing Assamese art and heritage alongside global exhibitions," Sarma said. JSW Foundation's Chairperson Sangita Jindal said through this collaboration, JSW is honoured to support the Assam government in creating a museum that will preserve India's cultural heritage and offer a platform for global cultural engagement. The museum will stand as a "testament to our shared heritage and artistic devotion as we believe in the power of art and culture to inspire communities." The museum will include state-of-the-art climate control facilities and security systems to ensure the preservation of the artefacts, the release added. PTI
